

# Navigating Beijing's Educational Landscape


A comprehensive guide to international school curriculums


Choosing the right international school in Beijing involves making several key decisions, with one of the foremost being the curriculum. In contrast to the standardized national curricula many of us experienced in our schooling, international schools in Beijing have the freedom to design their own, within certain parameters. For parents, this offers a diverse array of options, but the multitude of choices can be overwhelming, especially for those new to the process. To provide guidance, we've compiled a breakdown of some of the most prevalent curriculums available. It's essential to note that this guide doesn't endorse any specific curriculum as superior, nor does it imply that one school implements a curriculum better than others. Each school tailors and interprets its curriculum uniquely, so reaching out to school admissions offices for detailed information is crucial.

## Montessori

Age group: ECE/Kindergarten

Developed by Maria Montessori in the early 20th century, the Montessori approach is rooted in the belief that each child deserves respect as an individual and should be given the opportunity to learn at their own pace within a well-prepared classroom environment. In this approach, children are typically educated in mixed-aged classrooms rather than traditional grade levels. Teachers and classroom assistants work collaboratively to create personalized teaching and development plans, nurturing a child's physical and spiritual learning.







# From Kindergarten to First Grade: Navigating the Journey with Enthusiasm

Discover Val's transition from kindergarten to first grade

he transition from the whimsical world of kindergarten to the more structured environment of first grade marks a significant milestone in a child's educational journey. It's a time filled with new experiences, challenges, and the excitement of growing up. To gain deeper insights into this crucial phase, we sat down with Valiant Wang, a new first grader at Beijing City International School (BCIS), to chat about his experiences and perspectives on the world of primary education. Val graduated from kindergarten at BCIS and moved on to their primary school. Did BCIS prepare him well for his big educational endeavor to come? Let's find out.

Embarking on this journey together, we explore the intricate details of Val's daily routine, newfound responsibilities, and the delightful surprises that come with being a first-grader.

Val paints a vivid picture of their daily routine: "We mostly start from our homerooms with Ms. Liz. We kick off the day with Music on Thursdays, and a short investigation helps us understand the schedule for each day. After that, it's snack time. The afternoons are usually more enjoyable because I get to dive into independent reading and writing. Oh, and Mondays are extra special - it's swimming day, and I absolutely love it!" The transition from the less structured schedule of kindergarten to the more organized routine of first grade is evident. The introduction of specialized classes, like Music and Swimming, adds a layer of excitement and variety to each day.

"In 1st grade, I have reader's workshop, writer's workshop, and swimming. There are also other cool classes like Maker's

Space with Mr. Alex, but those are my secret fun activities." The mention of specialized workshops and the mysterious allure of "secret fun activities" underscores the expanding horizons of learning that come with the transition to first grade.

Being a first grader is a big deal. To Val, he's no longer a little kid. Jingkids asked him the big question: "Do you feel more grown up now that you're in 1st grade?" The response is an emphatic "Definitely! I know all the kids from my grade and many from 3rd and 6th grades. We hang out after school, and they call me 'Mini Monster'!" This newfound sense of camaraderie and the playful nickname showcase the social growth that comes with advancing to a higher grade level.

When asked if he has homework now, Val responds: "Nope, not from school. Sometimes, I have books to read from school, but I finish them quickly. My mom tutors me in reading and writing every day after school, and I get homework from that class, but it's fine." The absence of official school homework, coupled with the acknowledgment of additional work from home, reflects the gradual introduction to increased academic responsibilities.

"I miss the huge indoor playground, the kitchen where we used to bake cakes, and the LIBRARY!" The nostalgia for the indoor playground, the joy of baking in the kitchen, and the love for the library reveal the sentimental longing for the more carefree aspects of kindergarten.

Val had the privilege of starting out his school career at BCIS right from the start which prepared him well for first grade, and the transition to first grade was remarkably smooth, as the young learner confidently expresses, "I was so ready for first grade since, like, Pre-K." This statement underscores a sense of preparedness that extends back to their PreK days. The seamless shift from one academic level to another shows a well-prepared and selfassured student, poised and enthusiastic to confront the challenges and opportunities that come with a new grade level. His readiness sets a positive tone for his academic journey and shows both the child's resilience and the effectiveness of the school's preparation for their students.

Embarking on the adventure of first grade, Val's contagious enthusiasm adds vibrant strokes to the canvas of transitioning from kindergarten to primary school. Every day unfolds a tapestry of excitement, from engaging swimming lessons to undisclosed moments of fun. # Expert Tips on Making the Most of Your Open Day

Beijing's international school professionals share what to look for when you visit

can say with complete honesty that my first few school tours were a complete waste of time. I treated most of them like playdates where I was more interested in meeting other parents and seeing all the cute toys in the classrooms than anything else. Why? Were the schools terrible? Not at all! They were beautiful international schools that offered a wide range of wonderful activities and curriculums, but the entire experience went right over my head because I was so caught up in the excitement of my baby being old enough to start visiting schools that I wasn't paying much attention to anything other than the school's hardware and taking cute photos of my kid in class.

It wasn't until she aged out of nursery and I started really looking for schools that the tours took a different feel. It's the job of every school's marketing department to make them sound great, so you've got to see the place for yourself to get a feel for what you're sending your kid into.

So, for first-time parents, here are a few tips for when you're selecting your first school.

#### Should you take your child on the tour with you?

Most people say yes, and it's recommended if your child is older. But from personal experience, seeing a school with my partner and daughter when she was super young was more distracting than anything else. One or both of us were constantly minding her, which left the other to half-listen to whatever the school was saying. Yes, it's true that you should make sure that your child loves the environment, but let's face it, international schools in Beijing are pretty much all excellent and when you've got a toddler, it'll be hard for them to not love just about any school you choose. They're going to be fascinated by the new environment, new friends, and teachers, and they're going to cry and not want to go in the beginning. When they're that young, you need to be the decision maker, not them. Keep at least the first visit to just the adults. You can focus on what the school staff is saying, check out everything you want to see, ask as many questions as you want, and make informed decisions. Schools are welcoming. If you're serious about sending your child there after your visit, they'll let you bring your kid back for a visit at a later date.

## Do you need to meet the teachers?

If you're offered the chance go ahead and say hi, but don't be alarmed if you don't. Sometimes tours take place during teachers' off time and they're just not there. It doesn't mean the school's hiding them on purpose. Each school is different and the turnover rate for teachers varies, so even if you meet the current teacher for your kid's upcoming grade level, that doesn't mean they're going to be there next school year. Pay attention to the school's curriculum and philosophy and ask about how the school takes care of its teachers. Do they provide training throughout the year? We all benefit from refresher courses on how to best do our jobs.

What do the professionals have to say on the matter? We asked three educators whose job it is to organize open days and introduce their school to the community.

## What advice would you give parents to help them make the most out of a school open house?

"To make the most of a school open house for admission, parents should research the school beforehand, including its curriculum and values. Prepare questions to ask during the event, attend information sessions, and tour the facilities. Follow up with a thank-you note and ensure that the school aligns with their child's educational goals and values."

"Attending an open day can be an overwhelming experience. At BSB, we'll do our best to ensure you leave with a clear picture of our school so you can make an informed decision. Choosing a school for your child is one of the biggest decisions you can make, so here are some top tips to get the most out of your open day experience.



- 1. Prepare beforehand. Make a list of the things that are most important to you and your family. You may also want to think about your child's individual needs and interests. This will help you to focus your questions and observations on the open day.
- 2. Attend the principal's talk. At BSB, we always introduce you to the principal at the start of the event. This is a great opportunity to learn more about the school's vision and values.
- 3. Don't be afraid to ask questions. No question is too small or silly. The staff at the open day are there to help you learn as much as you can about the school."

# Independence, Adaptability, and Friendship

A student's first person's perspective on 14 years at boarding school: filled with lessons and lifelong bonds

fter spending a significant portion of my life, a total of 14 years, at Beijing Royal School (BRS), the most invaluable lesson I've garnered is how to make independent decisions. In a boarding school like BRS, students form a close-knit community where the responsibility for decision-making falls squarely on their shoulders. With the assistance and guidance of my advisors and mentors, I have the freedom to make choices that directly impact my life – a skill that will serve me well in the future when deciding on colleges or careers.

BRS has also honed my ability to adapt to diverse environments. With students hailing from various regions across China, each with their unique cultures and customs, attending a boarding school like this has allowed me to gradually develop the skill of adjusting and coexisting with individuals from different backgrounds and belief systems. Additionally, the diversity isn't limited to just the students; the teachers also comprise individuals from diverse backgrounds. This enriches my educational experience and provides me with the opportunity to learn from educators with a wide range of perspectives and experiences.

I still vividly recall my first experience living on campus. It happened during an English camp over my winter break in the 3rd grade. where we were required to stay at the school for a two-week session. Adapting to campus life was relatively easy, thanks to our school's routine of primary students taking a nap during the lunch break. We were all accommodated in the student dormitories, so staying on campus didn't pose much concern. However, the challenge lay in not returning home in the evening. As a day student prior to this, I had no previous experience of residing with friends. No one had ever taught me how to integrate into a closeknit group, and during the initial days of the camp, I felt anxious and frustrated, uncertain about how to handle unforeseen situations.

Fortunately, my tutor noticed my apprehension and paired me with a girl who also resided in the same dormitory. The presence of close friends makes adapting to a new environment much more manageable. Amy, the girl my tutor teamed me up with, was welcoming and provided insights into the life of a boarding student. We spent our evenings chatting about our daily experiences, and after tiring days of skiing, we would lie on our beds, gazing at

the ceiling as if it were adorned with stars. As the camp progressed, we even enjoyed playing hide and seek in our dormitories with our peers and resident advisors.

Although the winter camp was brief, it marked my first exposure to an unfamiliar environment. This experience boosted my self-confidence, preparing me for various future endeavors such as traveling abroad to participate in numerous events, including camps, exams, and joining music theatre troupes. I became adept at handling unexpected situations and fostering new friendships.

I know the first question on every parent's mind. How does a school ensure safety for young boarders?

The school is on top of keeping the little ones safe. They've got all these different staff members who are experts in different things, like the clinic doctors and the dorm administrators.

Back in 3rd grade, we were assigned to dorm rooms with four kids, and they were strict about keeping girls and boys in separate rooms. We had this one dorm administrator living on our floor, who was essentially our ultimate guardian angel. She'd handle the







morning wake-up calls, make sure the lights were out at night, and be on top of any emergencies that came up.

If we ever got sick or injured, our dorm administrators would rush us over to the school's clinic for a quick checkup. And guess what? There were these 24-hour clinics right on the first floor of our dorms, which was pretty convenient. If things got serious, they'd give our parents a call for further treatment. They had our backs all the time. Plus, kids were allowed to bring phones on campus, but we only had access to them at specific times, such as lunchtime or dinner times so we could be in constant touch with our parents, family, and friends outside of school.

Boarding at a school like BRS taught me how to adapt to different societies and environments I might encounter in the future. It instilled in me the value of forging meaningful connections with strangers and thriving in unfamiliar surroundings — a lesson that transcends mere words and can only be truly grasped through experience.

Now, as a senior at BRS, I approach my upcoming journey abroad with confidence, knowing that BRS has equipped me with the skills to navigate diverse environments and build relationships with others.

Aside from the academic grind, this school is all about keeping our mental health in check. They've got a bunch of student-led clubs and mental health awareness campaigns going on. And when it comes to dealing with personal stuff, they've got our backs.

Over at the school's Psychological Consultation room, they host all sorts of psychology events to help us out. But it's not just about that – they encourage us to connect with our counselors and teachers if we're going through tough times. It's like a whole support system to make sure we're doing okay mentally. It's

pretty awesome, honestly.

Looking back, it's heartwarming to remember how my journey at BRS began. My parents chose BRS because it is an esteemed international school, and it has played a significant role in nurturing my English language skills from a tender age. What adds to the nostalgia is the boarding school atmosphere at BRS, which naturally led to the formation of deep, lifelong friendships with classmates. As boarders, we practically live together, sharing our daily activities and experiences. These moments when we are together not only strengthen our academic bonds but also give us evenings filled with heartfelt conversations about our lives outside of classes. Graduation is approaching, and I am treasuring my final days at Beijing Royal School, realizing that these familiar walls will forever feel like a second home.







# From Involved Parent to Director of Admissions

Dr. Erin Crocetti's inspiring journey at British School of Beijing, Sanlitun

Dr. Erin Crocetti is a woman who gets things done. Even back when I first knew her as a homemaker, she was already so actively engaged with her three kids' schools, after-school lives, and the expat community in Beijing that it was hard to imagine her fitting more into her already-full life. But with her sharp intellect and ceaseless drive, Crocetti has now taken on a new role – as director of admissions and marketing at British School of Beijing, Sanlitun (BSB Sanlitun).

Crocetti last worked in an office some 20 years ago, but throughout her years of raising three daughters, she has stayed active in the workforce, consulting for non-profit organizations such as International Federation of Red Cross (IFRC). Her PhD in Geography is a testament to her love of research – which comes in handy in her new role – and her previous work experience has put her in close engagement with schools. All of this, plus how involved she is as part of the parent association at BSB Sanlitun and how much she appreciates the school culture, demonstrates how she is the perfect fit for this new role.

"I was a fan of the school even before we were in China," Crocetti shares, "Our eldest daughter was already enrolled in a school using the British curriculum, and we liked the idea of sticking with that. In addition to getting information about Beijing schools online, we reached out for recommendations from our base of friends and colleagues, and BSB Sanlitun popped up a few times, mainly to do with location."

Crocetti reveals how they decided on the school, "We spoke to a family who had just returned from Beijing and their main recommendation when we asked about housing, whatever AQI was, buying a car, etc., was to first pick the right school and their daughters had spent their time in China at BSB Sanlitun. They raved about the teachers and the parent community. We decided then to



Crocetti goes on to say how she appreciates the way the school managed the Covid crisis. "During lockdowns and home-schooling, I knew that the teachers were going to reach out to my daughters in a way that made them feel safe and that they (even at home) were still part of a class community ... That was incredibly difficult to do. Every day during the worst of times, they still had an amazingly supportive outlet to engage with and learn from. It made it so right for me to choose to professionally link my name to them."

As director of admissions and marketing at BSB Sanlitun, Crocetti oversees a small but powerful team of four other women who personally meet with prospective families as well as teachers and students in the school to ensure that both sides are being supported so that the school can deliver the best education they can for the students. Crocetti says: "A morning for me can be chatting with a new family about how their child is loving our library, listening in on a rehearsal of a class show, meeting

with the Parent's Association to speak about the amazing events that they organize, and then getting ready to have an even more diverse afternoon 'at the office.' I love it."

When asked about the best part of her new career, Crocetti said, "My team. They're creative, supportive, and ambitious, and chatting with them at the start of each day about our schedules, opportunities, challenges ... It's the best part of my day, planning out our time together."

2024 will see many exciting events for the school community at BSB Sanlitun. Apart from their annual Book Week in March and Sports Week in April, the school will host a series of bespoke workshops by experts from MIT and Juilliard, for parents, students and staff alike, as well as STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics) activities with Formula 1 Engineering teams!

Crocetti aims to keep the school's amazing community feel while also planning for growth as more families as well as staff are able to come to, and return to, Beijing. "I want to continue the same level of outreach and communication between the school and parents that I experienced before I took on this role." In line with that aim, there will be upcoming in-school Open House events for prospective families and don't forget to attend their weekly Baby Book Club, Baby Group and Baby Dance meet-ups every Monday, Wednesday and Friday, open to the broader Beijing community.
